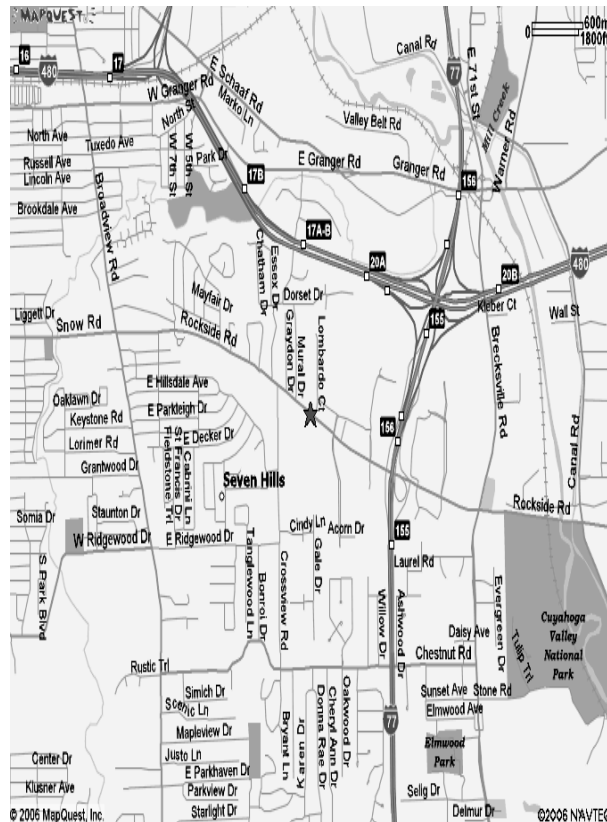

Rev. McGuire is a current member of Family and Children's First Council, Medina County Schools Crisis Response Team, Medina Ministerial Association, and Medina County Mental Health Professionals.
